The Pastor's message - Why Easter Matters

"Jesus said, "It is finished."

Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit." — John 19:30

Now, if this is where our story stopped, we would not be living as people of the resurrection. We would be stunted at the crossroads, having no clue where to go and what to do.
