Please do not use any previous year's envelopes.



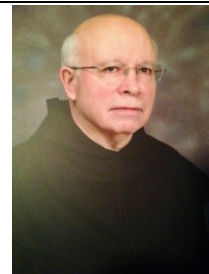
This weekend is ShareLife Sunday
