I am particularly grateful for the trust you placed in me during the most intimate moments of your lives. It has been an honor and a privilege to celebrate the sacraments with you, to witness the baptism of your children, to bless your marriages, and to accompany you in times of grief and loss.

When I had my stroke and during my recovery, so many of you from the parish, friends from abroad prayed, visited, called and checked on me regularly. You made certain that I was OK and you all supported me in many ways. To continue my recovery I will be on medical leave for the next three months and then, I will take up new responsibilities at the St Thomas Carmelite Province in India, I carry with me the memories and experiences I have shared with all of you. You have left an indelible mark on my heart, and I will forever cherish the relationships we have formed and the moments we have shared.

Let us continue to support and pray for one another, even as our paths diverge. I have no doubt that this community will continue to grow in faith, love, and service, guided by the Holy Spirit.

No matter the distance that separates us, God continues to unite us through the celebration of the Mass, for we all share and participate in the one Mass that is celebrated in Heaven for all eternity.


