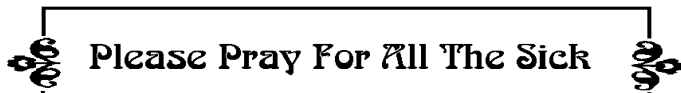

Someone defined father like this: 'A father is a man who carries pictures in his purse where his money used to be.' A father may be described in various ways! God had sent to us love in various forms and one of them is you, the Father. In the Book of Exodus God commands us (20.12) "honor your father and you mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the Lord your God is giving you." One reason God commanded us to honor our father is because of the meaning of the word "father." In the verb form, the word "father" means 'the founder, to be the foundation, to author.
