The Mass will take place at 2:30 p.m. on **Sunday, February 8 at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond Street, Toronto)**. The Mass is open to all, but due to space restrictions those wishing to attend are asked to register online. Milestone anniversary celebrants will be assured of reserved seating. All other seating is on a first-come, first-served basis.
