Blessed Fr. Michael McGivney Relic

Father Michael McGivney was an American catholic priest of Irish descent. At 16, he began studies for the priesthood in Quebec, and later completed his education in Baltimore, Maryland and was ordained for the Diocese of Hartford in 1877.

Father McGivney began his priestly ministry as curate at St. Mary's Church in New Haven Connecticut. In 1882, Fr. Michael McGivney formed the Knights of Columbus among a small group of St. Mary's parishioners to promote charity, unity and fraternity, assisting widows and orphans.

Pope Francis approved Father McGivney's beatification on October 31, 2020 after confirming a miracle attributed to McGivney's intercession.

The Sacred Relic of Blessed Fr. Michael McGivney will be at St. Martin of Tours Parish (adoration Chapel) from Saturday, October 4, 2025 until Saturday, October 11, 2025.

On Friday, October 10, 2025 at 7pm, all are invited to attend a Healing Mass followed by Adoration here at St. Martin of Tours with Fr. Felix.
